Thanks to all who continue to come out and support our Lodge. As most of you know we have made some changes to lunch and dinner hours and our specials. We do not take these adjustments lightly. Rest assured that we have looked at a lot of data and after a lot of discussion we felt that these changes were necessary.

How can you help our Lodge? Support the special events and band nights we provide. Come out for our delicious reasonably priced food and drinks. We offer a safe place to enjoy yourself.
